





LanguageCert (IESOL) Testing Centre

Seafield offers LanguageCert International ESOL (English for Speakers of Other LanguageS) exams. LanguageCert is designed for non-native speakers of English worldwide wanting to provide documented evidence of their knowledge of English, for study or employment. We run B2 Communicator tests and C1 Expert tests regularly. We also help students arrange Online Proctored examinations so they can take the examination in the comfort of their own home.
